

Schedule Study Rooms Online

You no longer need to visit the Circulation Desk to make a study room reservation and obtain a key. Use our new scheduling software to book one of our 11 study rooms. From the Library's homepage, click on Schedule a Room under the Services heading.



Reserving a group study room is quick and easy.

- * Select the date that you want to reserve a room.
- * Click on the time slot and room number you want to reserve.
- * Login with your MSU credentials (D2L username/password or GID and library password).
- * Enter a brief description (name or class) and click on submit.
- * At the time of your reservation, proceed to the room. If the room is occupied, inform the group that you have a reservation at that time.

As we approach finals, the study rooms will be very popular so we just ask that you abide by a few of our rules.

- * Rooms may be reserved by groups of 2 or more for 2 hours each day. One reservation per day for each group.
- * Reservations can be made up to 8 days in advance.
- * Students, faculty, staff and the community may reserve the rooms on the 1st floor (rooms 1A-1F). Members of the public will need to go to the Circulation or Reference desk to have a reservation made for them.
- * 3rd floor group study rooms (rooms 327-332) are reserved for student use only.
- * When not reserved, Group Study Rooms are open on a first come, first served basis.
- * Group Study Room users without a reservation must vacate the room when requested by a group with a valid reservation.
- * Conversation should be held to a reasonable level, as rooms are not soundproof.

Library Extended Hours

Need a late night study space? Come study at the Library. We are starting extended hours a week earlier this year. From Sunday, December 4th through Thursday, December 15, Renne Library will be open the following hours:

Saturday & Sunday: 10am – 2am
Monday -Friday: 7am – 2am



Color Printing

If you need to print a final project in color, you will need money on your CatCard other than your \$7.50 of free printing. To add money to your CatCard, stop by the CatCard office in the lower level of the SUB or go to www.montana.edu/catcard where you can add money with a credit/debit card.

Alternatively, you can purchase a copy card at the Circulation Desk for \$5.00 which has \$4.25 on it. (There is a \$0.75 charge for the card.)
