INTERLIBRARY LOAN: RESOURCE DETECTIVES

If you want a book, article, or other resource that is not in the library collection, then you need to know about the amazing Interlibrary Loan department at Renne Library. MSU students, faculty, and staff can fill out an online form at the Request It! link (found by clicking "Request" on the library homepage.) Then your library staff gets to work, searching for the resource you desire. The ILL literary sleuths work to track down your request and get that book or article into your hands, if possible. You can even request a scan of an article or chapter currently in our library's collection!

To use this resource, use your NetID and password to log-in to the library homepage. Fill out the online Request It! form as accurately and completely as possible.
