



The practical function of ceramics is to be utilitarian. Beyond this, my work must have an aesthetic responsibility. The position developed from this commitment enables me to express myself.

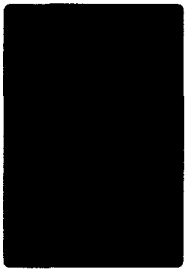
