Feeling a bit reflective in the first weeks of the new year? Take a trip down memory lane with these library tidbits from a self-guided tour document used in Renne Library in 1983.

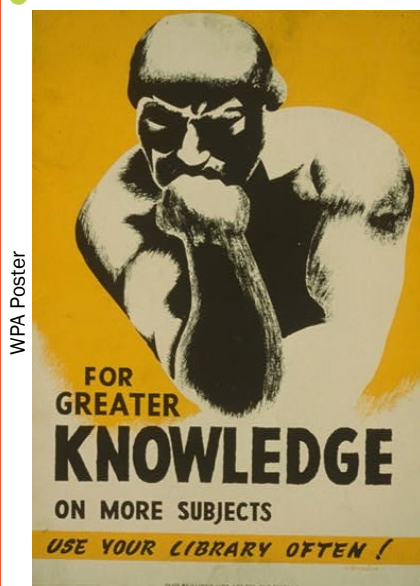
- Students could rent a typewriter and work in a designated typing room on the 2nd floor.
