### **InfoTracPowerSearch: Taking Research to a Whole New Level**

Tired of searching multiple databases to locate scholarly and magazine articles, books, newspaper articles and more? PowerSearch is to the rescue!

By combining the content of five different databases (InfoTrac General OneFile Academic OneFile, Opposing Viewpoints Reference Center, InfoTrac Custom Newspapers, and the Gale Virtual Reference Library) into one easy to search interface, researchers can now search more efficiently and effectively.

This database is updated daily and contains over 100 million documents. Yes, that's right; Over 100 million documents and that number is increasing every day. With this many documents, you will never be at a loss for resources ever again.
