Where: Bozeman Public Library Community Room

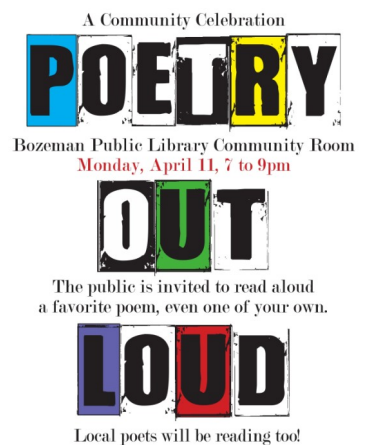
Light refreshments will be served.
